CALL TO ORDER

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 6:35 P.M. BY MAYOR MCMURRY, AT WHICH TIME IT WAS DEEMED THERE WAS NOT A QUORUM PRESENT. THEREFORE, IT WAS ANNOUNCED IT WOULD JUST BE A WORK SESSION.

THE FOLLOWING IDEAS WERE PRESENTED AT THE WORKSESSION TO BE VOTED ON AT A REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING.

THE MAYOR MENTIONED HE IS GOING TO HAVE A COUPLE OVERSEE THE RV PARK FROM THE THIRD WEEK OF MARCH THROUGH OCTOBER.

OFF ROAD VEHICLES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED. NO BICYCLES OR GOLF CARTS ON WALKING TRAIL. COUNCILMAN GORDON SUGGESTED THE MAYOR TALK TO CHIEF WILLHOITE ABOUT GOLF CARTS ON STREETS.

PETS MUST BE ON LEASH. HAVE DISPOSABLE BAGS AVAILABLE TO CLEAN UP AFTER THEM.

QUIET TIME WILL BE EITHER FROM 10 P.M. – 8 A.M. OR 11 P.M. – 8 A.M.

FIREARMS BANNED. MAYOR WILL TALK TO ATTORNEY NICK MARSH ABOUT THE CONCEALED CARRY.

SITES WILL HAVE TWO VEHICLE LIMIT. ALL VISITORS MUST REGISTER AT OFFICE, PARK IN GRAVELED LOT & DISPLAY VISITOR PARKING PASS IN VEHICLE. THEY MUST ALSO LEAVE BY 11 P.M.

UNACCEPTABLE CONDUCT – NO EXCESSIVE DRINKING, NO CLOTHESLINES, NO WASHING OF VEHICLES/CAMPERS, NO OUTSIDE WOOD ALLOWED – FIREWOOD WILL BE SOLD ON SITE. FIRES IN FIRE RINGS ONLY.

BAGGED ICE WILL BE AVAILABLE ON SITE.

1 NIGHT MINIMUM STAY DURING WEEK & 2 NIGHT MINIMUM STAY ON WEEKENDS. MAXIMUM 15 DAY STAY UNLESS DURING THE MONTHS OF NOVEMBER THROUGH MARCH, CONTRACTORS COULD STAY LONGER.

RATES: \$ 35/NIGHT (INCLUDES WI-FI). HOLIDAY RATES WOULD BE A MINIMUM 3 NIGHT STAY INSTEAD OF RAISING THE PRICE.

TENT CAMPING IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY.

NO INDIVIDUAL TRASH CANS AT SITES. TRASH WILL BE PICKED UP AT EACH SITE IN THE MORNING. IT WAS SUGGESTED TO HAND OUT 2 BAGS AT CHECK-IN.

PICNIC TABLES AT EACH SITE, AT PAVILION, AS WELL AS TENT CAMPING AREA.

THE MAYOR SAID TREES WOULD BE PLANTED AROUND THE SETTLING POND. COUNCILMAN GORDON ALSO SUGGESTED SLATS BE PLACED ON FENCE SO IT CAN'T BE SEEN.

SPEED LIMIT – 5 MPH

THE MAYOR WANTS TO OFFER FREE WEEKEND FOR LOCALS, TENTATIVELY FOR APRIL 13, TO OFFER SUGGESTIONS.

MATT WHITTAKER IS WORKING ON WEB SITE DESIGN. COUNCILMAN GORDON SAID HE NEEDS TO BE SCHEDULED FOR COUNCIL MEETING SO QUESTIONS CAN BE ASKED.
