Public Meeting Minutes

Carroll County Middle School

February 16, 2012

7:00 P.M.

A proposed LWCF grant application from the City of Carrollton for a Splash Park in the City's Point Park was discussed at the public meeting on February 16, 2012.

Mayor Gene McMurry called the meeting to order at 7 p.m. in the cafeteria of the Carroll County Middle School. Mayor McMurry explained the Splash Park idea, which has been on the City's agenda for a number of years. The proposed Splash Park, as part of the City's Master Plan for Point Park development, would cost approximately \$158,000.

There was agreement among the participants that the Splash Park would be a good idea. Many residents noted that there was a lack of appropriate recreational opportunities for children in Carrollton, and that the Splash Park was needed.

The LWCF grant application was one part of the public meeting, which also drew comments from residents on other planned developments at Point Park.

The meeting adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
